### Lost and Found

### Absentee Calls

**A reminder to all parents/guardians:** To ensure safety, if your child is absent or tardy, parents are asked to call the school and may do so at any time. You may call the night before or the morning of the absence. Library Street has an automated telephone system. After calling 886-1255, listen for prompt number 5 to report the absence.


