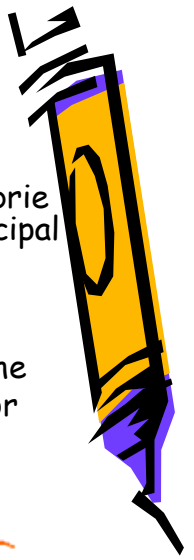

If your child is tardy, he/she should report to the office for a tardy slip.
